## Parent Guide To The New Termly Profiles

The Termly Profiles were devised after a consultation with all parents/carers. We hope you find the new format of reporting to you more useful and informative.

- The termly profile is split into three curricular areas: Literacy, Numeracy and Health & Wellbeing.
- Each area contains the learning targets for your child.
- The teacher has also written the level that they are working on at the moment. This is a guide to the expected levels of progress. Some children may be working below or beyond the expected level. It would normally take a child three years to be secure in a level.
- The teacher will tick the progress comment for your child and your child will tick how they feel they are progressing.
- There is also a section for effort for Literacy, Numeracy, Health & Wellbeing and Homework.
- The teacher has also written the level that they are working on at the moment. This is a guide to the expected levels of progress. Some children may be working below or beyond the expected level. It would normally take a child three years to be secure in a level.

### Expected Levels

P1 - Early Level (E3 - secure)

P2 - First Level (F1)

P3 - First Level (F2)

P4 - First Level (F3 - secure)

P5 - Second Level (S1)

P6 - Second Level (S2)

P7 - Second Level (S3 - secure)

There is also a teacher comment at the end of the profile.

Attached to the profile is a feedback sheet for yourself and your child to complete. We would like your child to write comments about their progress independently if possible.

Parents of children in P1 and P2 can write the comments for them.
